**Principle Passage:**

**1 Corinthians 13:1-7 New International Version (NIV)**

**13** If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. <sup>2</sup> If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. <sup>3</sup> If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing. <sup>4</sup> Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. <sup>5</sup> It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup> Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. <sup>7</sup> It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

Opening Premise: We live in a society of neighbors.  
We must do our service to others in ways that are responsible, respectful and healthful.

**Mark 8:1-8 New International Version (NIV)**

**Jesus Feeds the Four Thousand**

**8** During those days another large crowd gathered. Since they had nothing to eat, Jesus called his disciples to him and said, <sup>2</sup> "I have compassion for these people; they have already been with me three days and have nothing to eat. <sup>3</sup> If I send them home hungry, they will collapse on the way, because some of them have come a long distance." <sup>4</sup> His disciples answered, "But where in this remote place can anyone get enough bread to feed them?" <sup>5</sup> "How many loaves do you have?" Jesus asked. "Seven," they replied. <sup>6</sup> He told the crowd to sit down on the ground. When he had taken the seven loaves and given thanks, he broke them and gave them to his disciples to distribute to the people, and they did so. <sup>7</sup> They had a few small fish as well; he gave thanks for them also and told the disciples to distribute them. <sup>8</sup> The people ate and were satisfied. Afterward the disciples picked up seven basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over.

An Impromptu Picnic

Jesus wanted to honor, help and make sure the people that listened to him had strength, spiritual and physical to get home.

Disciples **MUST** be facilitators of LOVE!

Disciples **MUST** be extensions of Jesus **NOT** extinguishers of Jesus!

Relevant Question: What does it mean to honor someone?

**It means you put your pride on the side and let it wait there while you help another person with his/her problems.**

**Honor is looking at another person and saying "we may not be the same, but you are a human being and we are in this boat together. So I am going to help you.**

The challenge is to honor **ALL** people!

Are people hooked on church or THE Church?

Closing Thought: We **must** make the decision to honor other people, regardless of social, cultural, or economic differences and it must be an intentional decision. We **must** have at the forefront of our thinking that we will seek to know what is best for others, and then choose to do what is best for others in the community where God has planted us.
